Knockout plugs for tubes, wiring and controls are provided in all models to make installation of a KF Air Conditioner easy, and the installation of other types of heaters impractical.

We can still supply Air Conditioner, Part No. 200005, for initial installation or replacement on all Kaiser or Frazer cars previous to 1949 models.
