Subject: KF Radios and Antennas for 1951 Kaiser and Frazer Cars

We are pleased to announce the same satisfactory 8-tube Radio will be continued for use on both the 1951 Kaiser and Frazer cars.

This 8-tobe Radio, with its large speaker, delivers the ultimate in selectivity, quality of tone and adequate volume without distortion. Six (6) stations may be pre-selected for automatic tuning and each one tuned in with its own individual push button, or you may manually tune other stations without disturbing the setting of those stations pre-selected for automatic tuning. The tone may be controlled to suit the listener from treble to bass.

This Radio, Part No. 200002, can be installed in the 1951 Frazer without any change from previous model installation. Due to the design of the 1951 Kaiser instrument panel, the speaker is mounted above the Radio instead of below as in the 1951 Frazer and all previous models, making it necessary to replace some parts in the regular Radio package. These replacement parts, together with complete instructions for installation, are included in a Conversion Kit, Part No. 100144, which is to be ordered by you as required.

We will continue to supply both the manual and vacuum operated Antennas. Two (2) lengths of the manually operated Antennas are available - the 62" for normal reception areas and the 93" for weak signal localities. The length of the lead-in is ample so that these Antennas can be mounted either on the right or left front fender. You will note that new part numbers have been assigned to the manual Antennas for use on the 1951 Kaiser. This is necessary due to the contour of the front fenders and the location of the lower mounting bracket.

The KF vacuum operated Antenna has many advantages not found in the manually operated type. A touch of the button from the driver's seat raises or lowers the Antenna to the height which gives the best reception. Distant stations can be brought in more clearly with the Antenna fully extended, and it is not necessary to stop the car, get out and raise the Antenna, as is the case with the manually operated Antenna. Instant adjustment can also be made to lower the Antenna when entering and leaving a garage. Parts are included in the vacuum Antenna package for installation on all Kaiser and Frazer cars, including the 1951 Kaiser.
