Subject: K-F Windshield Washer, Part No. 100169

Although Windshield Washer, Part No. 100105, can be installed on 1951 Kaiser cars, we have found that certain changes are desirable for easier installation.

We, therefore, prepared a new Windshield Washer package, 100169, which includes all jets, correct lengths of tubing, and a revised bracket for mounting the water jar. Because of the wide curving windshield glass, better results and operation can be obtained by the use of new jets to properly distribute the water over the windshield. These jets are easily installed in the openings which have been provided in the wiper pivot base. New templates together with installation instructions have been prepared and are included in each package.
