Subject: Advance Body Parts List

Enclosed herewith please find copy of the Advance Body Parts List covering body replacement parts for the Frazer Model F-47 and the Kaiser Model K-100.

While this Advance Body Parts List does not contain any illustrations, the text is arranged in groups of related parts so no difficulty should be experienced in locating and selecting parts required to make body repairs. Under the Group Index you will find a complete list of the Groups which go to make up the complete book, and under each Group the Sub-Groups into which each Group is divided. In the back of the book will be found a Standard Parts List giving a description and size of all standard parts used, together with a Numerical Index listing all of the parts contained in the book in numerical sequence.

Before making extensive use of this book, we would suggest that the General Information Section in the front of the book be carefully read and studied. This section contains useful information as to the system employed in compiling the book, instructions for ordering parts, etc., and a thorough knowledge of these subjects will enable you to obtain full value from the book.

Wherever possible we have given you the before and after body numbers where changes have been made in production affecting parts interchangeability. You will find a number of parts listed, however, where the words "up to" and "after" are used without the body number being shown as to when these parts became effective in production. This indicates that the new parts, although released for production, had not been used on the production line at the time this book went to press. Just as soon as the effective points are available you will be notified by bulletin so you can add the "up to" and "after" body numbers to those items where this information is lacking.
