This guard consists of an "L" shaped clear plastic blade attached to a ball and socket base which is mounted at the top of body center door pillar as shown in the descriptive illustrated circular attached. Wind Guards installed in pairs on right and left hand side of the car can readily be adjusted to deflect the air away from the rear seat passengers, and when not in use, folded out of the way against the roof.

These Wind Guards are a very desirable addition to cars not equipped with vent windows, as front windows can be lowered for ventilation without creating an excessive and objectionable draft on rear seat passengers. The installation and operation are very simple and the results most satisfactory.
