Subject: Radio Service Stations

It is the desire of both General Electric and your factory to provide service facilities in the field for the repair of KF Radios, which they are manufacturing for us, which will be second to none.

In an effort to establish such an organization quickly, General Electric offered Service Station Franchises to the established Zenith automobile radio service stations. While many of these accepted the GE franchise, we find that many Kaiser and Frazer dealer points are still without a GE Warranty Service Station and, therefore, without a satisfactory local service connection for obtaining warranty service and repairs to KF Radios.
